I GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Information regarding procurement:

- 1.1 Procurement is arranged in line with the requirements of Cabinet Regulation No 104 of 28.02.2017 *Regulations Regarding Procurement Procedure and Procedures for Application Thereof to Projects Financed by a Contracting Authority* and other laws and regulations applicable to public procurement.
- 1.2 Procurement is conducted for the purpose of a project co-financed by European Union.

3. Description and Scope of the Subject of Procurement:

- 3.1. The subject of procurement is **Inner fibre dryer**, according with the Technical Specifications (Annex 2 to the Regulation).

4. Timeframe and Place for Performance of Contract:

- 4.1 Place of performance: Prohorova iela 13, Jelgava, LV-3002.
- 4.2 Timeframe of performance: Equipment must be delivered by **30.10.2026** at the latest.

5 Place, Date, Time and Procedures for Submission of Tender:

- 5.1 **Tender has to be submitted by March 19, 2026 17:00** at the address of the Contracting Entity at Lietuvas iela 16A, Eleja, Elejas pag., Jelgavas nov., LV-3023, in person or by mail, or sent to email: liga.avena@asnsfood.com
- 5.2 If the tender is sent by mail, the Supplier undertakes responsibility for receipt of tender by the deadline specified in Clause 5.1 hereof.

II REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPLETION AND SUBMISSION OF TENDER

6. The Supplier may submit only one version of tender.
7. Tender must fully conform to the requirements specified in this Regulation and its Appendices.
8. If Tender is submitted in person or by mail, information to be provided on the package is as follows:
 - 8.1 SIA ASNS Ingredient, Lietuvas iela 16A, Eleja, Elejas pag., Jelgavas nov., LV-3023;
 - 8.2 *Name and address of the sender*;
 - 8.3 *Note: For procurement “Inner fibre dryer”, ID No ASNS2026/1*;
9. Tenders are to be submitted in printed version in **Latvian or English**. If the Supplier submits documents in a foreign language, the **Latvian or English** translation of documents certified by a signatory or authorised person (with the respective power of attorney or its copy attached) must be attached.
10. Prior to the expiry of the time limit for the submission of tenders, the Supplier may amend or withdraw the tender it has submitted.
11. All appendices of the tender constitute its integral part.

12. Tender is signed by the signatory or authorised person of the Supplier (with the respective power of attorney or its copy attached).
13. The Supplier may certify the correctness of all derivatives and translations of documents by one certification.
14. All information provided by the Supplier in tender must be true. If the Contracting Entity has doubts as to accuracy of information provided by the Supplier in tender or authenticity of a copy of any document, the Contracting Entity may request that the Supplier confirms accuracy of information and/or presents an original document confirming the fact or submits a certified copy of the document. Said documents are to be submitted within the time limit specified by the Contracting Entity.

III REQUIREMENTS TO SUPPLIER, DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED BY SUPPLIER

15. Qualification Requirements for Supplier:

- 15.1 The Supplier is registered with the Commercial Register of the Enterprise Register of the Republic of Latvia or with a similar register abroad in the manner established by the laws and regulations.
- 15.2 The Supplier has **experience in the supply of food industrial equipment** during the previous 5 (five) calendar years (2021, 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, as well as 2026), where **the amount of at least one contract has been no less than 500'000 EUR.**
- 15.3 The Supplier's **average financial turnover (net) for the last 3 (three) closed financial years** (2022, 2023 and 2024) is **not less than EUR 1'000'000.** If the Supplier is established later, then the Supplier's financial turnover must meet the above requirement in a correspondingly shorter period of time.
- 15.4 The Supplier has developed the offer independently of the competitors.

16. Selection Documents to be Submitted by Supplier:

- 16.1 Application of the Supplier, as per Annex 1.
- 16.2 **Copy of the business entity's registration certificate** (if the Supplier is registered with the Commercial Register of the Enterprise Register of the Republic of Latvia or with a similar register abroad in the manner established by the laws and regulations, or, in the absence of such certificate (laws and regulations of the respective country does not stipulate issuance of a registration certificate), information on registration number and time of the Supplier, stating the competent authority in the country of registration that can confirm the fact of registration, if necessary.
- 16.3 **Information regarding the Supplier's previous experience**, in accordance with Paragraph 15.2. (Annex 6)
- 16.4 **Supplier's statement on financial turnover**, in accordance with Annex No.4 to the Regulation.
- 16.5 **A confirmation signed by the Supplier** regarding the independently developed tender must be submitted (**Annex No.5**)

IV TECHNICAL BID

17. The Supplier **prepares and submits the technical bid in line with the requirements of the subject of procurement (Annex 2 hereto).** Technical bid confirms the compliance of offered equipment and services to the Regulation and developed technical specifications.

V FINANCIAL BID

18. **Financial bid** is submitted in the form of the **Financial Bid form (Annex 1** and estimate in accordance with **Annex No. 2)**.
19. The Supplier may not indicate “0” costs in the cost items in the financial offer. Prices must be quoted in euros (EUR) to two decimal places.
20. Prices must include the costs of all services, materials and equipment, labor costs, delivery, assembly and installation costs, the costs of necessary preparation, inspections and ancillary works, the cost of using machinery and accessories, all taxes (except VAT), fees and charges that are binding to the Supplier in order to ensure the performance of quality works, as well as all risks, including possible increases in costs, as well as all administration, document preparation, coordination and transport costs related to the performance of the works specified in the Annex 2.

VI EVALUATION OF BIDS AND SELECTION CRITERIA

21. Evaluation of Bids:

- 21.1 Evaluation of bids is conducted in a closed meeting.
- 21.2 Minutes are taken of bid evaluation meetings.
- 21.3 Evaluation of bids is conducted as follows:
 - 21.3.1 compliance of the Supplier’s selection (qualification) documents with the requirements of the Regulation. Non-conforming bids may be excluded from further evaluation if the Contracting Entity establishes that non-conformity has material impact on the possibilities of bid valuation and decision-making;
 - 21.3.2 compliance of the Technical Bid of the Supplier with the description of the subject of procurement specified herein;
 - 21.3.3 evaluation of the Financial Bid of the Supplier and check of arithmetical errors. The procurement commission may correct arithmetical errors in the Financial Bid of the Supplier informing the Supplier of such correction.
- 21.4 Arithmetical errors in bids are corrected as follows:
 - 21.4.1 if numbers in words differ from numbers in digits, numbers in words will be taken into account;
 - 21.4.2 if the unit price differs from the total price obtained as a result of multiplication of a unit price and the number, the unit price will be taken into account and the total price will be adjusted;
 - 21.4.3 if an arithmetical error is detected in the bid in respect of tax calculation, the Contracting Entity corrects such figure in line with the tax calculation procedure laid down in laws.
- 21.5 **Criterion for selection of bid: offer with the lowest offered contract price in EUR without VAT.**
- 21.6 If the Supplier states in its bid that the bid is not final and may be reviewed, the Contracting Entity and the Supplier may conduct negotiations. During negotiations with the Suppliers that have submitted their initial bid by the deadlines specified herein, the Contracting Entity will coordinate the opportunities of the Supplier and its own needs. No negotiations will be conducted if the Supplier that has submitted its bid in conformity with the requirements of the regulation has stated in its bid that the bid is final and may not be reviewed or if the bid leads to a conclusion that it is final and will not be reviewed.

22. The Contracting Entity may invite other suppliers to submit their initial bids and to participate in negotiations at any time before the final decision as to the award of contract is made.
23. The Contracting Entity informs all suppliers that have submitted their initial bids of the selected bid as soon as possible, though no later than within 5 (five) business days of the decision date, by sending such information via mail, fax or electronic mail.

VII RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF PROCUREMENT COMMISSION

24. Rights and Obligations of Procurement Commission:

- 26.1. Bids are evaluated by the procurement commission of the Contracting Entity. The procurement commission may invite expert(s).
- 26.2. The procurement commission may correct arithmetical errors in the Financial Bid of the Supplier. The procurement commission informs the Supplier of the correction of errors and the corrected bid amount.
- 26.3. The Contracting Entity may terminate the procurement procedure if objective justification is in place.
- 26.4. If the procurement commission establishes that the bid in question is abnormally low, prior to rejection of such bid, the procurement commission requests in writing that the Supplier provides a detailed explanation of essential provisions of the bid.
- 26.5. If the procurement commission establishes that the Supplier has not proven that such provisions of the bid are available to the Supplier that allow offering of such low price, the commission declares that the bid is abnormally low and does not consider it any further.
- 26.6. If the Contracting Entity in the course of evaluation establishes that the information provided in the submitted documents is unclear or incomplete, the Contracting Entity claims that the Supplier or a competent authority explains or supplements information included in such documents.
- 26.7. In the course of negotiations the Contracting Entity may request that the bids are explained, supplemented and improved.
- 26.8. The Contracting Entity will not enter into the service contract with the Supplier, if they are in conflict of interests, within the meaning of Section 12 of Cabinet Regulation No 104 of 28.02.2017, except for cases specified in Section 13 of Cabinet Regulation No 104 of 28.02.2017.
- 26.9. All other rights and obligations of the procurement commission not dealt with herein are regulated by Cabinet Regulation No 104 of 28.02.2017 *Regulations Regarding Procurement Procedure and Procedures for Application Thereof to Projects Financed by a Contracting Authority* and other applicable laws and regulations.

VIII RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF SUPPLIERS

25. Rights and Obligations of Suppliers:

- 27.1. The Supplier is obligated to give answers to the additional information requests of the procurement commission within the timeframe specified by the commission. If the Supplier fails to answer the questions posed by the commission when due, the Commission may exclude the Supplier from further participation in the procurement.

5. The tenderer has not knowingly, directly or indirectly, disclosed or will not disclose the terms of the tender to any competitor before the official date and time of the opening of tenders or the award of the contract.
6. The tenderer is aware that the Competition Law provides for liability for prohibited agreements, providing for a fine of up to approximately 10% of the infringer's net turnover of the last financial year and the tenderer may be excluded from participation in the procurement procedure.
